

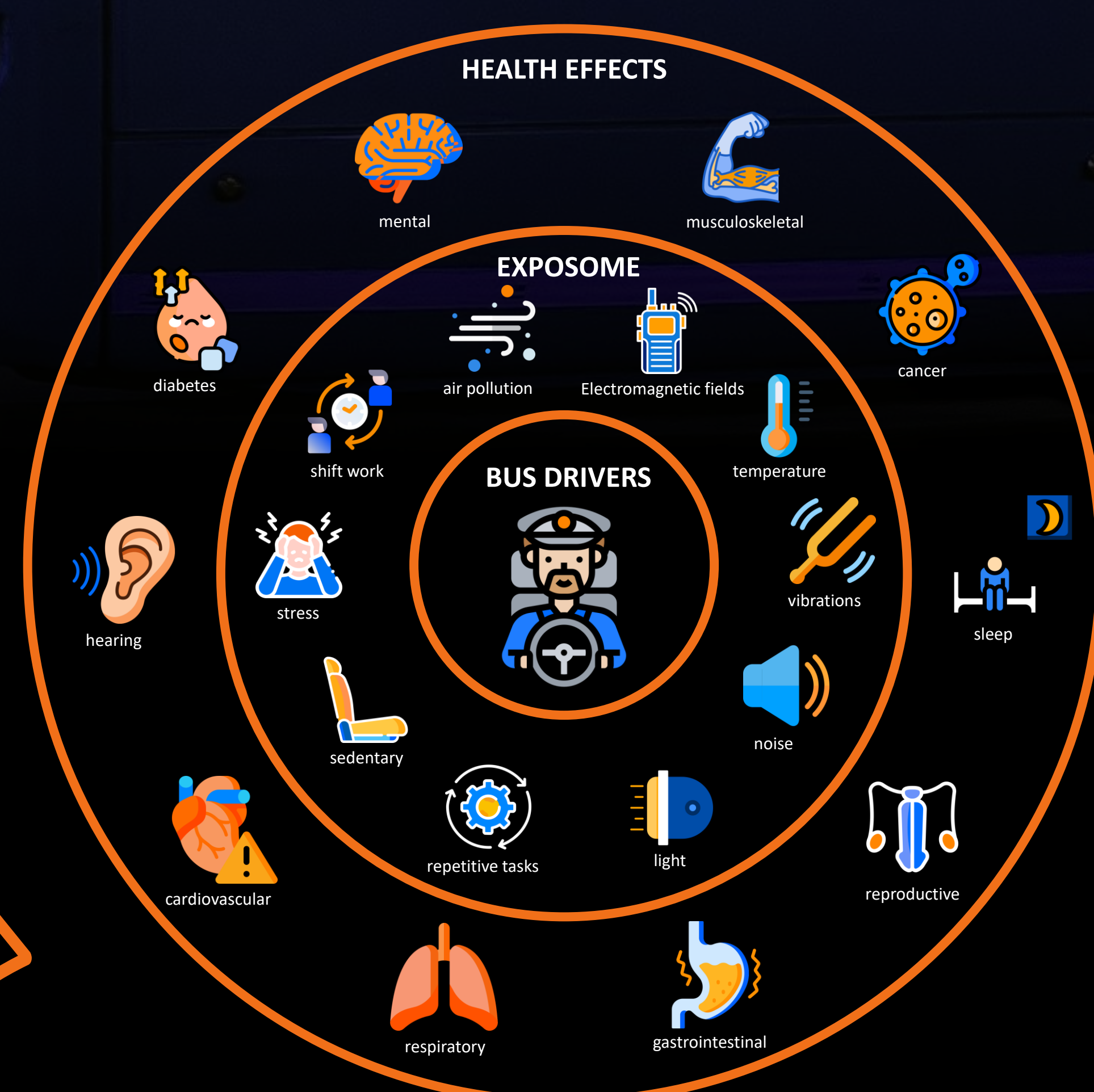

Promoting Effective Transport through Healthy Bus Drivers

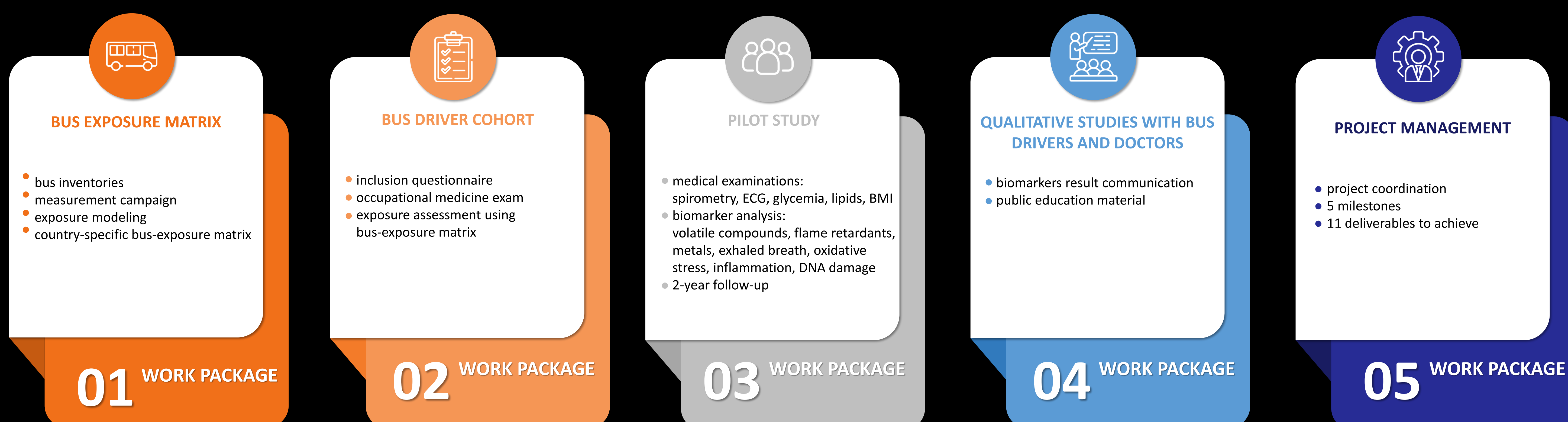


PROMETHEUS aims to yield immediate, impactful outcomes for the bus drivers and occupational health practitioners involved in the programming and delivery of the occupational medicine exams, which are compulsory in virtually all countries.

The ultimate goal is to transform these exams from regulatory control into a space of salutogenesis through personalized prevention, health education, and promotion.

PROMETHEUS aims to address the critical concern of bus drivers' health and wellbeing at work by improving the content and preventive effectiveness of the statutory medical examination using biomonitoring and health education material

• Stakeholder Engagement •

Early engagement with bus drivers, public transport safety managers, and occupational health physicians, ensuring the development of a salutogenesis and sustainable wellbeing

• Evidence-Based Policy Making •

Providing decision-makers with a solid evidence base to inform the national rollout of occupational health surveillance programs dedicated to bus drivers

• Public and Occupational Health Prioritization •

The project addresses a significant health challenge and a critical concern of bus drivers' shortage

• Capacity Building •

Training and involvement of early-career researchers, patients, and the public enable long-term research capacity in occupational health in participating countries

• Knowledge Dissemination and Impact •

Disseminate findings, directly benefiting knowledge user organizations with evidence to advocate for and implement changes in occupational health practices
